Toilet Training / Personal Care Policy

Statement of intent

Moat Barn Nursery believes that children should be encouraged to become independent with their personal care needs.

Aim

We aim to work in partnership with parents, to help them to promote and implement toilet training and personal care/hygiene.

Methods

- When a child is ready to start toilet training, we will work alongside the family to support their individual requirements.
- We will endeavour to maintain privacy at all times.
- Protective gloves will be worn at all times.
- Soiled items will be stored appropriately.
- Children will be encouraged to either sit / stand at the toilet, or on a potty. Depending upon their wishes.
- Information regarding the individual children will be passed onto parents.
- Proper hygiene methods will be utilised (Please refer to Hygiene Policy)
- Information will be displayed using recognisable symbols to encourage children to wash their hands.
- All children have access to the toilets and sinks at all times.
- Staff and visitors have access to a separate toilet and hand washing facility.
- A disabled toilet is available in the under two's area.
- Children wash their hands prior to meals and after handling the pets.
- Independence is encouraged.
